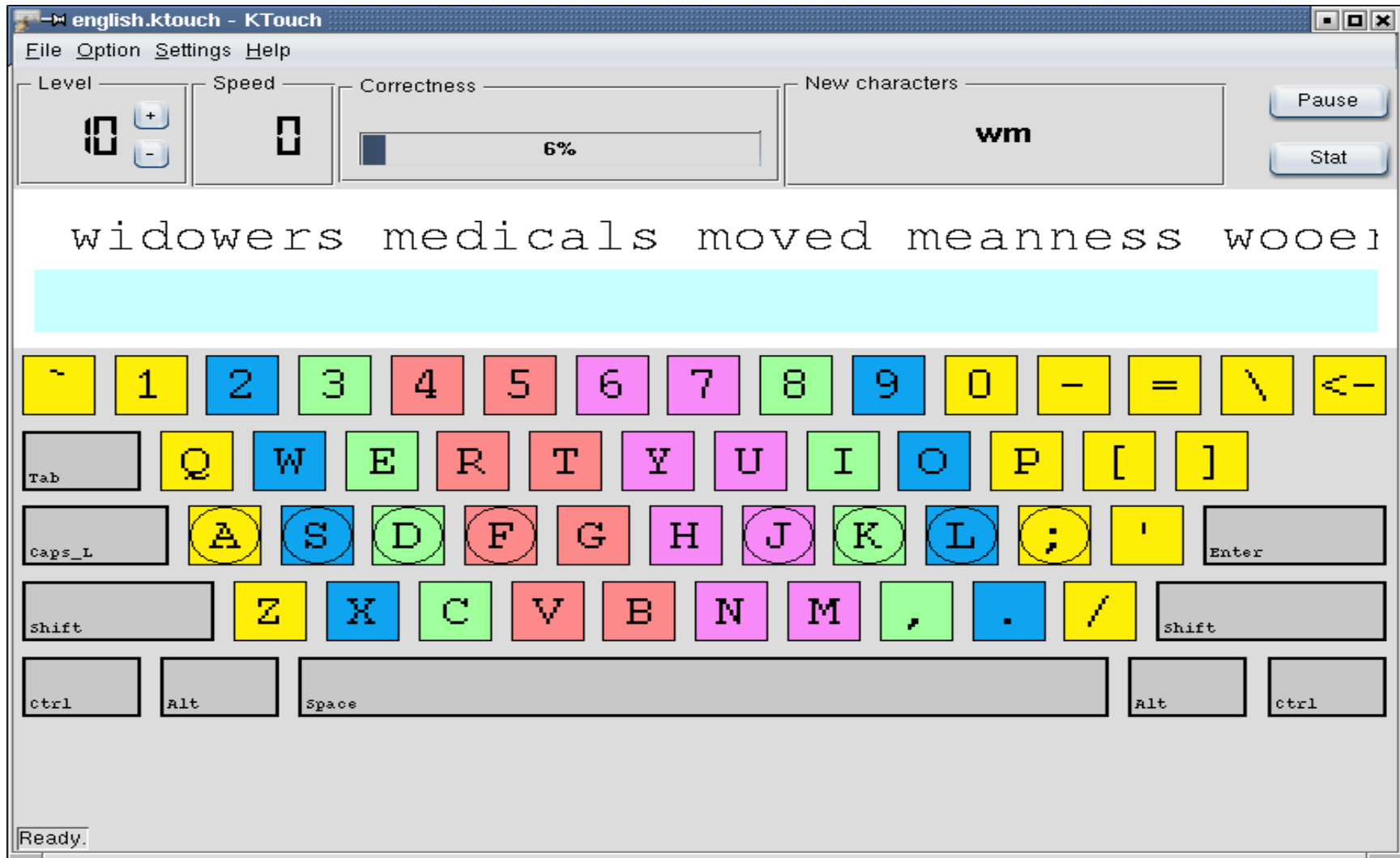


Past

Mission Statement

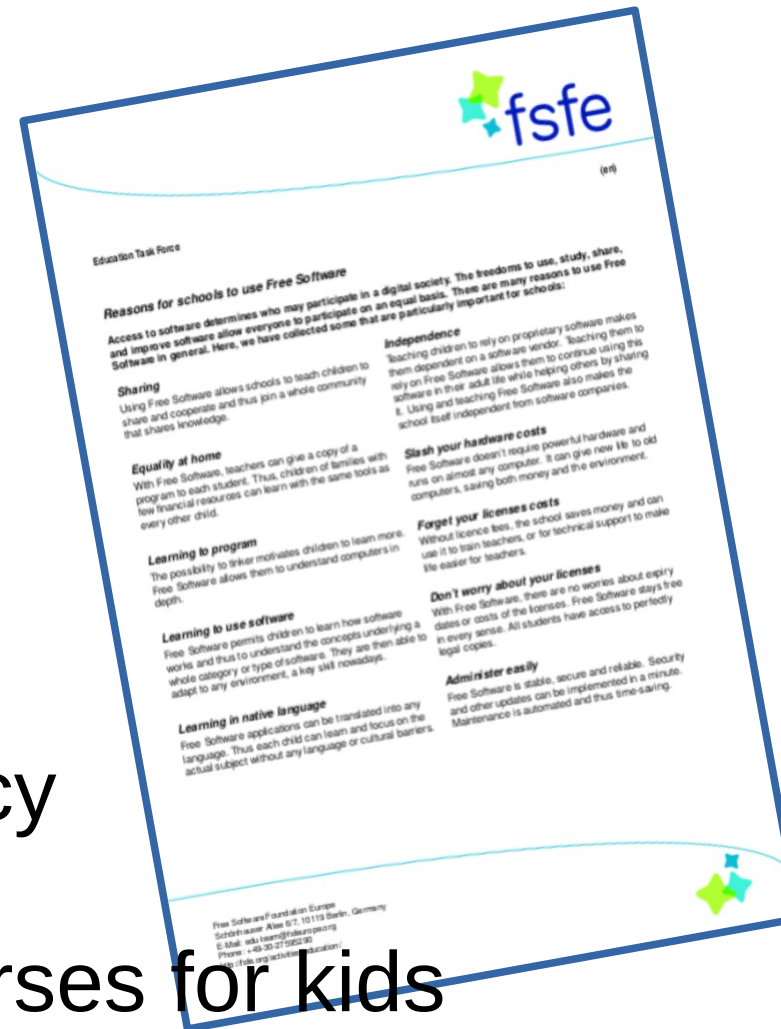
